Bundy Hill is an important historic and scenic area for the residents of Isabella County. At nearly 1300 feet, it is the highest point in Isabella County and is a glacial moraine remnant, as evidenced by several large boulders on its slopes. Owned by the Wakelin McNeel family since 1955, the Chippewa Watershed Conservancy recently signed a purchase agreement for the 100 acre property.
